In response to the COVID-19 pandemic the Town of Little Compton has decided to close South Shore Beach, Town Landing, Lloyd's Beach to vehicular traffic and parking. These properties will remain open to pedestrian traffic. In addition, there will be TEMPORARY NO PARKING on the following roadways:

South Shore Road
Ocean Drive
Rhode Island Road
Sakonnet Point Road (southern end)
Bluff Head Avenue
Grange Avenue
Quaker Hill Farm Road

Parking and traffic enforcement, as well as the Governor's Executive Orders regarding social distancing and groups of no more than 5 persons, will be STRICTLY ENFORCED. A reminder: persons from out-of-state entering Rhode Island for non-work-related matters are mandated to self-quarantine for a period of 14 days.

We regret any inconvenience this may cause; however, these mandates are being put into place for the safety and well-being of the residents of Little Compton.
